


# **B. Host country**B1. Italy





Italy is a peninsular country in south-western Europe extending into the central Mediterranean Sea which shape reminds a high-heeled boot. Two major islands are part of this country: Sardinia, which is an island of the west coast of Italy, and Sicily, at the southern tip (the "toe") of the boot. Italy is bordered by Switzerland and Austria to the north, Slovenia to the east and France to the west. The country also shares a border with 2 tiny independent states, San Marino and the Vatican, both of which are entirely surrounded by Italian territory. Italy has an area of 301,230 square kilometers and a coastline of 7,600 kilometers. With around 61 million inhabitants it is the fourth most populous EU founder member state. Italian is the official language spoken by the majority of the population, but as you travel throughout the country you will find that there are several distinct Italian dialects depending on the region you're in. French is spoken in the northwest and German in the northeast.

The history of Italy begins with the arrival of the first hominins 850,000 years ago at Monte Poggiolo, a hill in the Emilia Romagna region, and can be characterized as two periods of unity separated by a millennium and a half of division. From the sixth to third centuries BCE the Italian city of Rome conquered the hole peninsula and The Roman Republic (and later the Roman Empire) dominated Italy for many centuries, and furthermore established the culture and civilization of Western Europe in general, including the adoption and subsequent spread of Christianity as state religion at the end of the 4th century.

The decline and collapse of the Western Empire by the end of the 5th century is taken to mark the end of Late Antiquity. A Lombard Kingdom of Italy was established, although parts of the peninsula remained under Byzantine rule and influence until the 11th century.



The Lombard kingdom was incorporated into France and ultimately the Holy Roman Empire, although the rise of city-states, and especially the powerful maritime republics in the medieval period led to political fragmentation. Ultimately, after the disastrous Italian Wars, the peninsula was divided among the major foreign powers of Early Modern Europe, Spain and Austria, and later fell to the French Empire under Napoleon I, the Papal States being reduced to the control of the Holy See over Rome.

With the rise of nationalism and the idea of the nation state in the 19th century, the peninsula was unified in the late 19th century. The new Kingdom of Italy, established in 1861, quickly modernized and built a large colonial empire, colonizing parts of Africa, and countries along the Mediterranean. Part of the victorious allied powers of World War I, Italy defeated its historical enemy, the Austrian Empire. Soon afterwards, however, the liberal state collapsed to social unrest: the Fascists, led by Benito Mussolini, took over and set up an authoritarian dictatorship. Italy joined the Axis powers in World War II, falling into a bloody Civil War in 1943, with the Fascist faction finally defeated in the spring of 1945.











In 1946, as a result of a Constitutional Referendum, the monarchy was abolished. The new republic was proclaimed on 2 June 1946. In the 1950s and 1960s, Italy saw a period of rapid modernization and sustained economic growth, the so-called Italian economic miracle.

The country, coming back to international politics among Western democratic powers, joined the European Economic Community (which has later constituted the European Union), the United Nations, NATO, the G7 and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development. Italy plays a prominent role in regional and global military, cultural and diplomatic af-

Together with Greece, it is acknowledged as the birthplace of Western culture. Not surprisingly, it is also home to the greatest number of UNESCO World Heritage Sites in the world. High art and monuments are to be found everywhere around the country.

It is also famous worldwide for its delicious cuisine, its trendy fashion industry, luxury sports cars and motorcycles, diverse regional cultures and dialects, as well as for its beautiful coast, alpine lakes and mountain ranges (the Alps and Apennines). No wonder it is often nicknamed the Bel Paese (the Beautiful Country).



Italy has many climate zones, and could be far from the stereotypical Mediterranean climate. Most of Italy has hot, dry summers, with July being the hottest month of the year. Autumns are generally rainy. Winters are cold and damp (hence often foggy) in the North, and milder in the South. Conditions on peninsular coastal areas can be very different from the interior's higher ground and valleys, particularly during the winter months when the higher altitudes tend to be cold, wet, and often snowy. The Alps have a mountain climate, with cool summers and very cold winters.

With 48.6 million tourists a year (2014), Italy is the fifth most visited country because it offers a rich combination of masterpieces from different areas, blending landscape and culture, history and art, architecture and city planning - it offers an exciting journey through time, from the Ancient Greeks and Romans to the present day, which is also filled by a wealth of art and culture.

Italy is the land of the opera. Many composers are world renowned for their creative operas. Think of music composed by these famous Italians: Rossini, Donizetti, Puccini and Giuseppe Verdi.

Italy is also home to other fine famous artists: great poets and literary geniuses. Dante, Boccaccio, Petrarca are certainly the most famous writers, but many others influenced the world like Machiavelli or contemporary writers like Luigi Pirandello or Umberto Eco.

Italians are also famous for their inventions and discoveries. The Italian explorers Christopher Columbus and Amerigo Vespucci discovered the Americas while Marco Polo explored the East.

Leonardo da Vinci was a scientist and artist who was the first to prove the world is round and not flat and Alessandro Volta, was the pioneer who did studies in electricity, hence the name 'Volt' describing a unit of electricity. And last but not least, Italians love sports. Cycling, skiing, soccer and motor racing are just some of the sports Italians have very strong interest in and good teams of sportsmen and -women. The Italian soccer league is followed by many people abroad too: Inter, Milan, Lazio, Roma and Juventus are just some of the Italian soccer teams which are favoured.

**B2. Castione della Presolana** 



Castione della Presolana is a beautiful village situated in the province of Bergamo, the ideal destinations for those who love art, culture and sports, thanks to its well-appointed touristic offerings. This village is a gem sorrounded by mountains which has been a tourist destination since the beginning of the last century, as demonstrated by the presence of numerous Art Nouveau villas.

Though troughout the years Castione della Presolana has maintained its rural charm and its naive authenticity, it has also taken advantage of modern innovations and technology. It is situated at the base of Mount Presolana (2,521 m), which is also known as the "Queen of the Orobie" for its spectacular limestone faces, which are the same as the Dolomites. It is a paradise for those who like sporting or idling.

The climbing tracks of the Presolana Hollow are very famous, but you can also try hang-gliding, paragliding, golfing or riding a mountain bike.

The tourism in the area, in fact, takes advantage of masterpieces, whether manmade or nature made, all amidst a pleasant climate and ancient history.

The Alps and its foothills ("Prealpi") took shape about 200 millions years ago. At that time, the Triassic Era, the area was covered with water and coral reefs. Ever since the prehistoric times, the region has been inhabited by the people of the Vlacamonica (Camune). One of the most archaeological finds is the "Tomb of the Rannicchiati" which dates back to the bronze age.

In the fascinating Mills Valley whe can find the riuns of old water mills and of lime kiln ("calchere").

In the past the lime was used not only to build houses, but also for curious treatments against plants and animals disease. Among the artistic treasures of the area we should single out Renaissance and Baroque frescoes, ancient churches and sanctuaries and the "Santelle", a peculiarly genuine folk artworks.

**San Peder's ancient little church** inspires a moment's silence. Inside, you can admire Renaissance frescoes rich in pathos and realism.









Castione della Presolana offers many opportunities for those who love cultural events: art exhibitions (painting, sculpture, photography, and handcraft), shows and plays, concerts and religoius meetings. Castione also organizes some very "appetizing" soirées by presenting the local produce of the land as well as the processing techniques of honey, butter and cheese, desserts and local dishes. You may also enjoy folk festivals and many other special events. The most renowned are the mythical night marathon (in August), the classical music concert at the Baita Cassinelli, the exciting evenings

Among the local dishes you should definitely taste the "Polenta cusa col ciarighi" (a sort of maize porridge) with aromatic "lard" and spiced "panseta" (smoked bacon) and the wonderful "casonsei" (stuffed pasta), the local cheeses and the great variety of mushrooms.

at the observatory and the sweet Cake Festival.

The Province of Bergamo is situated in the eastern Lombardy Region, occupying the central section of the Alpine foothills and a small expanse of the Po River Plain. The north of the Province is a mountainous region, connected to the south by land straddling the hills and the Po River Plain.

The territory of Bergamo boasts landscapes that combine nature and human presence in a harmonious way.

It is believed that the name Bergamo is derived from the celtic Bergheim, meanig "town on the hill", which is entirely plausible given the principal feature of the old city, which is situated on the high ground between the plain and the mountains and framed by walls that sorround it on the top of the hill. It is precisely the outline of these walls that are the distinctive and unmisteakable feature of hilltop Bergamo, better known as Città Alta (Upper Town).

Upper Bergamo is the heart of the city and its beauty has enchanted



visitors for centuries. We recommend that you venture into the fascinating allyways of the old town following an itinerary that will show you the history and art of Bergamo. Stroll along the Fortified Walls and inside the Cittadella (citadel); enjoy the beauty of **Piazza Vecchia** (Old Square) and **Piazza Duomo** (Cathedral Square) then climb up to the Rocca (fortress).

There you can take in a mgnificent view of the city and if you're tired the Park of the Fort (known as Parco delle Rimembranze) welcomes young and old in the shade of its trees and some old relics including nothing less than a military tank! Visit the Santa Maria Maggiore basilica in Piazza Duomo. In addition to the wood inlays of Lorenzo Lotto, Romanesque frescoes and baroque decorations, you will also find the tomb of composer Gaetano Donizetti.

A stroll through Lower Bergamo is the perfect way to discover the most modern part of the city. The most significant places in the modern town are the Sentierone, where locals take their traditional passeggiata, and the Torre dei Caduti (Memorial Tower).

The Sentierone is overlooked by the Donizetti Theatre and its romantic monument dedicated to the maestro, who was born in Bergamo just outside the town walls, and the Church of San Bartolomeo, with its large altarpiece by Lorenzo Lotto "Madonna with Child on a throne and Saints".

### **B3. Vovinam Viet Vo Dao Federation Italy**

Vovinam Viet Vo Dao A.s.d. has been entered in the sport promotion agency A.S.I. (Italian Sports Associations) recognized by the Italian Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, by the Ministry of the Interior and by CONI by resolution of 1994.

After 25 years of engagement in organizing annual national championships, international tournament and the 1st European Championship in 2012, in 2015 we create VOVINAM VIET VO DAO ITALIA asd, an association born to manage the Italian National Team of Vovinam and the relationship between Italy and the International Federation like EWF and WWF. Italy is also one of the founder member of the EWF in 2010 in Paris and it hosted many international events. Grandmaster Nguyen Van Chieu came to Italy 4 times and other International Masters held training seminars in Italy.

#### **BY PLANE**

You can flight to Orio al Serio in Bergamo, Milano Malpensa or Milano Linate airport. If you arrive at Milano Malpensa or Linate you have to check on www.milano-aeroporti.it how to reach the International Airport of Orio al Serio. Notice that if your journey ends in Milano Linate, there is not a direct shuttle to Orio al Serio. You may reach Milano Centrale Train Station and then take the shuttle to Orio al Serio.

Once you get to Orio a Serio you may choose to get EVVF Shuttle to reach Castione della Presolana (see below paragraph) or use Public transportation\*\* (details below)

#### **BY TRAIN**

The main international train station is Milano Centrale (central station in Milan). From there, you can take the public shuttle and reach Orio al Serio airport (check the timetable on www.bergamotrasporti.it). If you arrive at Bergamo FS Train station, you may reach Orio al Serio airport with public transportation\*\* Once you get to Orio a Serio you may choose to get EVVF Shuttle to reach Castione della Presolana (see below paragraph) or use Public transportation\*\* (details below)

### PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION\*\* HOW TO REACH CASTIONE DELLA PRESOLANA

If you want to reach Castione della Presolana by yourself you may check the website www.bergamotrasporti.it and choose the track Orio-Bergamo Fs or Orio-Albino. Then check the web site www.atb.bergamo.it for the track Bergamo Fs-Castione or Albino-Castione.

#### BY CAR

It is very easy to reach Castione della Presolana. You have to take the motorway A4 (Milan-Venice) and exit for Bergamo or Brescia Ovest. Following the signs for Valseriana and Passo della Presolana after about 40 minutes you arrive in Castione della Presolana.



### **H4.** Competition Rules

In accordance with the EVVF Competition Rules Book.

#### Technical:

Đòn Chân Tấn Công: 4 competitors (each competitor performs 4 different Đòn Chân, 16 Đòn Chân different in total from number 6 to 21). Mixture Categories of Quyền Đồng Đội:Team with 3 males or 3 females (not a mixture team)

#### Fighting:

Contact Fight – weight maximum +200gr

Each Federation/Association may enter TWO (2) competitors/teams each category (both performance and fighting)

#### Performance:

Athletes born in 2000 or earlier can take part in performance competition

#### Fighting:

Athletes must be at least 18 year old (born before 7 July 2000)

#### Note

For athletes under 18 year old, the parental permission form must be signed by parent/guardian.





### **H. Competition regulations H5.** Elegibility

#### Nationality:

Athlete must have the same nationality of their National Federation/Association. Athletes are required to show their passport during the nationality control procedure in order to confirm their nationality.

#### Gender:

The female athletes may also have to undergo the gender control Athletes are not checking in case of having the gender certificate that is provided by mandated organizations.

#### **Uniform:**

All Vovinam uniform must be in accordance with the EVVF regulations All Vovinam uniform shall have the name of the country only All athletes shall compete with yellow belt without stripe All athletes are required to attend the opening, awarding and closing ceremonies in Vovinam uniform or official team uniform. It is expected that each delegation will have their own team uniform.

#### Health:

All competitors must have a health certificate (compulsory) to ensure that they are eligible for competitions.

Health certificate must be submitted together with national team's registration upon your arrival.

If the team does not fully send the health certificate for athletes, Organising Committee will not allow him/her to compete (both in performance and in fighting)

#### Insurance:

It is compulsory for all participants and members of delegations to have their own medical and personal trip insurance.

The EVVF and the Italian Organising Committee assume no liability or responsibility for the lack of insurance from participants and members of delegations. Chiefs of delegation have to sign the enclosed term of responsibility and return it by email before 10 May 2018 to the EVVF

### **H6.** Drawing

The draw will be held immediately after the delegations meeting under the control and observation of the EVVF.

Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the draw (a Maximum of 2 delegates will be authorised)

## **H. Competition regulations**

### **H9.** Making Complain - Sanction

Only head coach has the right to complain (complain must be in form of official letter and a fee of 200 Euro).

In case of complaining about human resource (athlete, referee), form must be submitted to Organizing Committee before drawing. In case of technical complain , form must be submitted to the Organizing Committee with in 10 minutes after the match .

The Organizing Committee will consider and make decision about the case before the next competition s take place. The Organization Committee will only return 150 Euros fee if only the issue is solved exactly as the official complain letter mention .

Penalty for not sending at least a referee in the championships is 300 euros.

This rule is applied for the countries which have more than 50 members. In case of any violation of the EVVF rules and regulations, the champion ship regulation or any misbehavior during competitions, including anti-doping codes or any involvement in a smear campaign of any attempt against the EVVF or Italian government, sanctions can be concluded by the Championships Organising Committee or EVVF leaders.

Athletes and Referees may be suspended of right/duty due to any disqualification or misbehaviors against the mentioned rules/regulation.
